Communicating individual Chartered status

Once you have qualified for Chartered status you can communicate this on marketing collateral using either the individual Chartered logo or individual Chartered text line.

Summary

- Use the individual Chartered logo to communicate your Chartered status
- If this is not possible you can use the individual Chartered text line
- Do not use the individual Chartered logo and individual Chartered text line together

Chartered text line

The use of the individual Chartered logo is the preferred means to communicate your Chartered status however where this is not possible you can use the individual Chartered text line:

Chartered Insurance Broker
Chartered Insurance Practitioner
Chartered Insurance Risk Manager
Chartered Insurer
Chartered Financial Planner

The individual Chartered text line can be used in your own corporate style, this includes colour, font, upper and lower case.

Chartered logo

The individual Chartered logo is available in black or white for use on light or dark coloured backgrounds.

- Don't use the individual Chartered logo smaller than 23mm
- If the above is not possible use the individual Chartered text line instead
- Maintain the correct space around the logo.

Sizing

The size at which the individual Chartered logo will be displayed will vary depending how and on what it is being used.

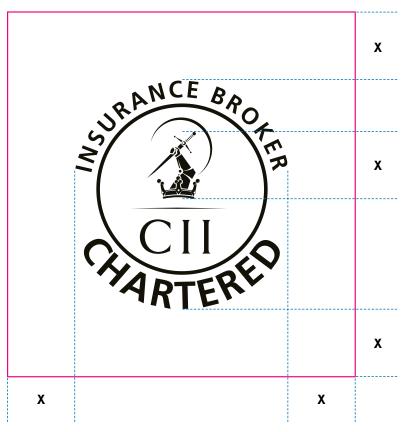
To ensure the individual Chartered logo stands out, a degree of free space around it is required. Do not place text or graphics in this free space.



The recommended minimum size at which the individual Chartered logo should appear is 23mm.

This may not be possible when including the individual Chartered logo on your business stationery or for email signoffs, where it may need to appear slightly smaller. Every effort should be made to ensure the logo remains legible – where this is not possible, the text line should be used as an alternative (see page 8).

X = the height of the arm and sword within the logo

Corporate Chartered status instructions

The corporate Chartered logo is to be used to communicate to your clients when your company achieves Chartered status. Ideally the corporate Chartered logo should be displayed in gold PMS 872. If this is not possible it can also appear in black, white or a dark colour in your corporate colour palette.

Summary

- Use the corporate Chartered logo to communicate your Chartered status
- If this is not possible you can use the corporate Chartered text line
- Do not use the corporate Chartered logo and corporate Chartered text line together.

Chartered text line

The use of the corporate Chartered logo is preferable to communicate your Chartered status however where this is not possible you can use the corporate Chartered text line:

Chartered Insurance Brokers Chartered Insurers Chartered Financial Planners

The corporate Chartered text line can be used in your own corporate style, this includes colour, font, upper and lower case.

Chartered logo

The corporate Chartered logo is available in black or white for use on light or dark coloured backgrounds.

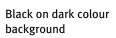

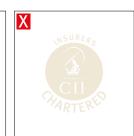

- If it's not possible use the corporate Chartered text line instead
- Maintain the correct space around the corporate Chartered logo.

Sizing

The size at which the corporate Chartered logo will be displayed will vary depending how and on what it is being used.

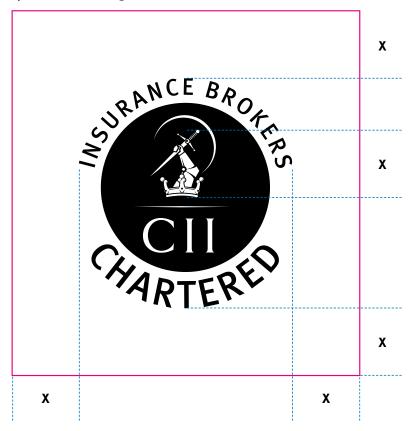
To ensure the corporate Chartered logo stands out, a degree of free space around it is required. Do not place text or graphics in this free space.



The recommended minimum size at which the corporate Chartered logo should appear is 23mm.

This may not be possible when including the corporate Chartered logo on your business stationery or for email signoffs, where it may need to appear slightly smaller. Every effort should be made to ensure the logo remains legible – where this is not possible, the corporate Chartered text line should be used as an alternative (see page 14).

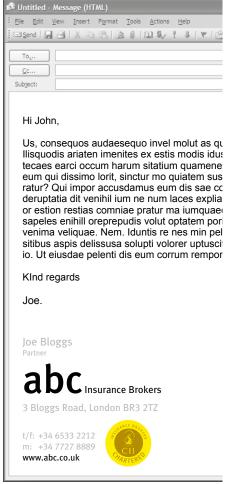

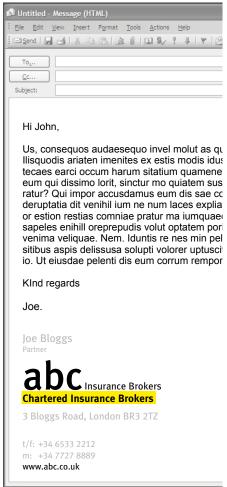

- Corporate Chartered text line can appear in your own corporate font and colour.

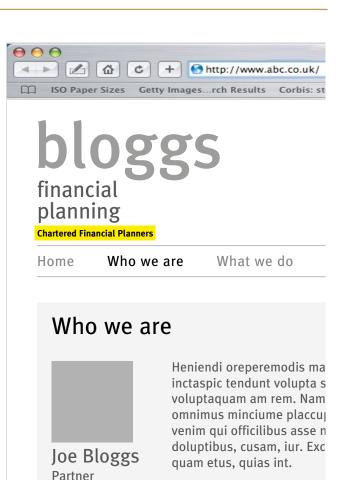

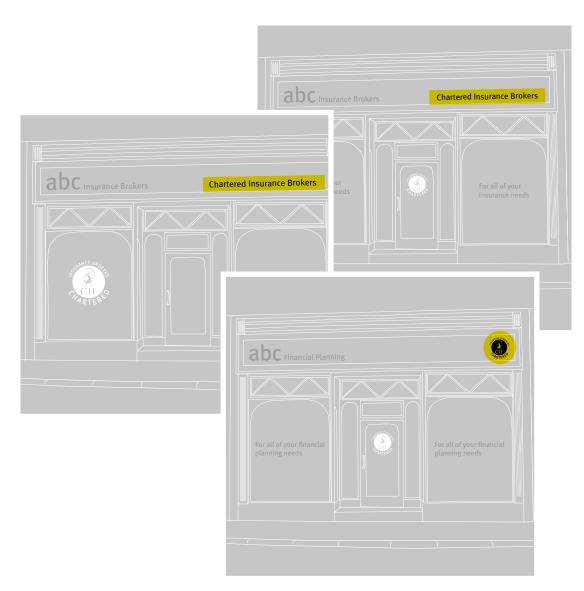

Use of the corporate Chartered logo on shop front

The corporate Chartered logo and corporate Chartered text line can be used together on your office premises to communicate the chartered status of your business. This allows the corporate Chartered text line to be used on your fascia and be readable at a distance by the public.

A few examples showing the use of the corporate Chartered logo and text line are shown opposite.

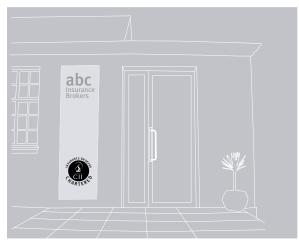

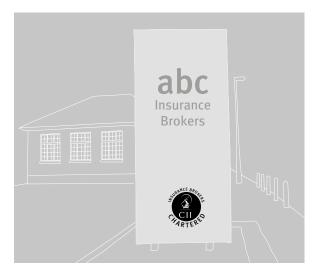
Use of the logo on shop front

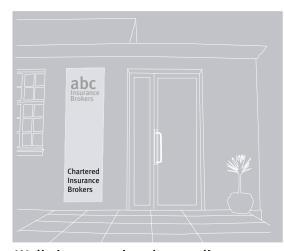

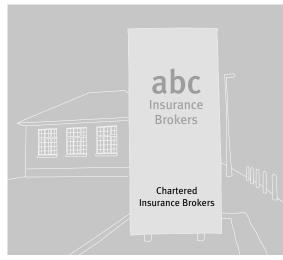
Wall signage using the logo.

Using both individual and corporate Chartered logos

Summary

- Do not use both individual and corporate Chartered logos together
- Use a combination of Chartered logo and Chartered text line.

Individual and corporate logos

When you need to communicate on a business card both corporate and individual Chartered status a combination of text line and logo must be used, depending on the emphasis you wish to give.

The options shown opposite show the combinations that can be used.
